Goals and vision


Main goal

The core is experiential knowledge and the values of reciprocity and equality.














Reciprocity and equality

Experiential knowledge contributes to reciprocity because:

- Sharing an experience stimulates exchange and cooperation: it goes back and forth.
- Sharing one's own experience helps others to tell their own stories.

"The words of others help me choose my own words"



Some conclusions from the social work field, freely translated to nursing and social work education
