
What happens if you learn from your experiences...? and use it for personal growth...?




What happens if you learn from the experiences of others... and use it for personal growth of both of you...?

WHY THIS PROJECT?


- High rate of dropout from higher education
- Waste of talent and resources
- System is often excluding and stressful
- Emphasis on individual performance, not on personal development and collective learning
- Emphasis on theoretical and technical knowledge / skills, excluding personal experiences

WHY THIS PROJECT?


- Bringing back experiential knowledge on the stage




WHAT WE ARE DOING
