Mend the Gap is an established approach for working in partnership with people in communities who often feel most excluded from services and support. We will also be sharing experiences of working in partnership with young unaccompanied young people and together, critically explore the effectiveness of this approach by placing focus on changed outcomes and the impact of **people power**.
